Wikipedia offers this definition: Interior design is a field within environmental psychology. It is about the study of how environment affects the behavior of inhabitants, with the aim of maximizing positive effects.



For instance, interior design studies have shown that crowded environments—like low income high-rise projects—contribute to violence, while harmonious environments can make people more peaceful. That makes interior designers part artist and part social engineer.

Interior designers are found in corporations, architectural firms, urban planning, real estate (staging), and private consulting. Those choices make interior


