# Home Renovation Realty TV: The Show that Started It All

This Old House premiered 40 years ago in 1979 on public TV, and was hosted by a cranky craftsman named Bob Vila. It was the first live TV show to depict home renovation from top to bottom.

Over the course of 13 half-hour episodes, Vila led a skilled team of electricians, plumbers, and carpenters in restoring a single home, usually an old Victorian or craftsman style...the kind that were a real challenge, but you knew would be breathtaking when reborn. The team tore out walls, uncovered rot, re-crafted ornamental cornices, rebuilt fireplaces, and replaced floors. The first season saw a quarter of a million viewers every week and the show went on to win 18 Emmy awards.

This Old House also gave rise to an entire genre of imitators who made home renovation look easy and fun, having us believe they could make-over an entire house in the same amount of time it takes the rest of us to clean the bathroom.

HGTV, which started in 1994, took note of the show's popularity, as did

other channels. Soon the format of home renovation shows locked in. We went from the real reality of Bob Vila and his team, taking months to meticulously restore a home, to the fake reality of fix and flip shows where the workmanship is sometimes shoddy and the real behind-the-scenes process is fraught with occasional lawsuits.



I encourage you to look up the very first This Old House episode on YouTube (season 1, episode 1). You might discover the old bones of that show are more pleasing to the eye than the fast makeover shows of today.

Either that, or you'll find the pace too slow by today's standards.
