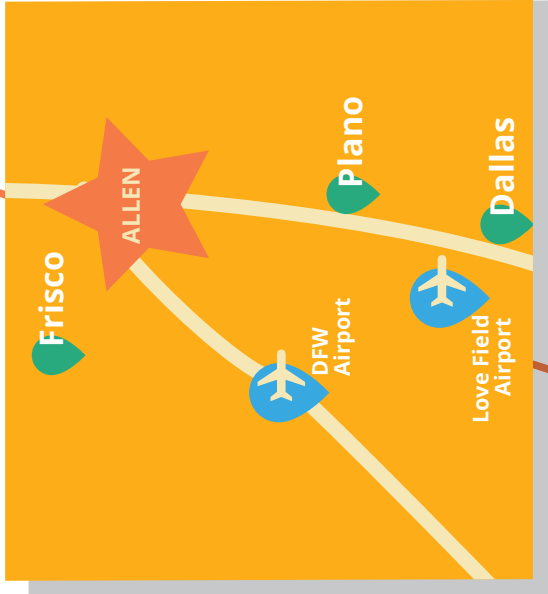
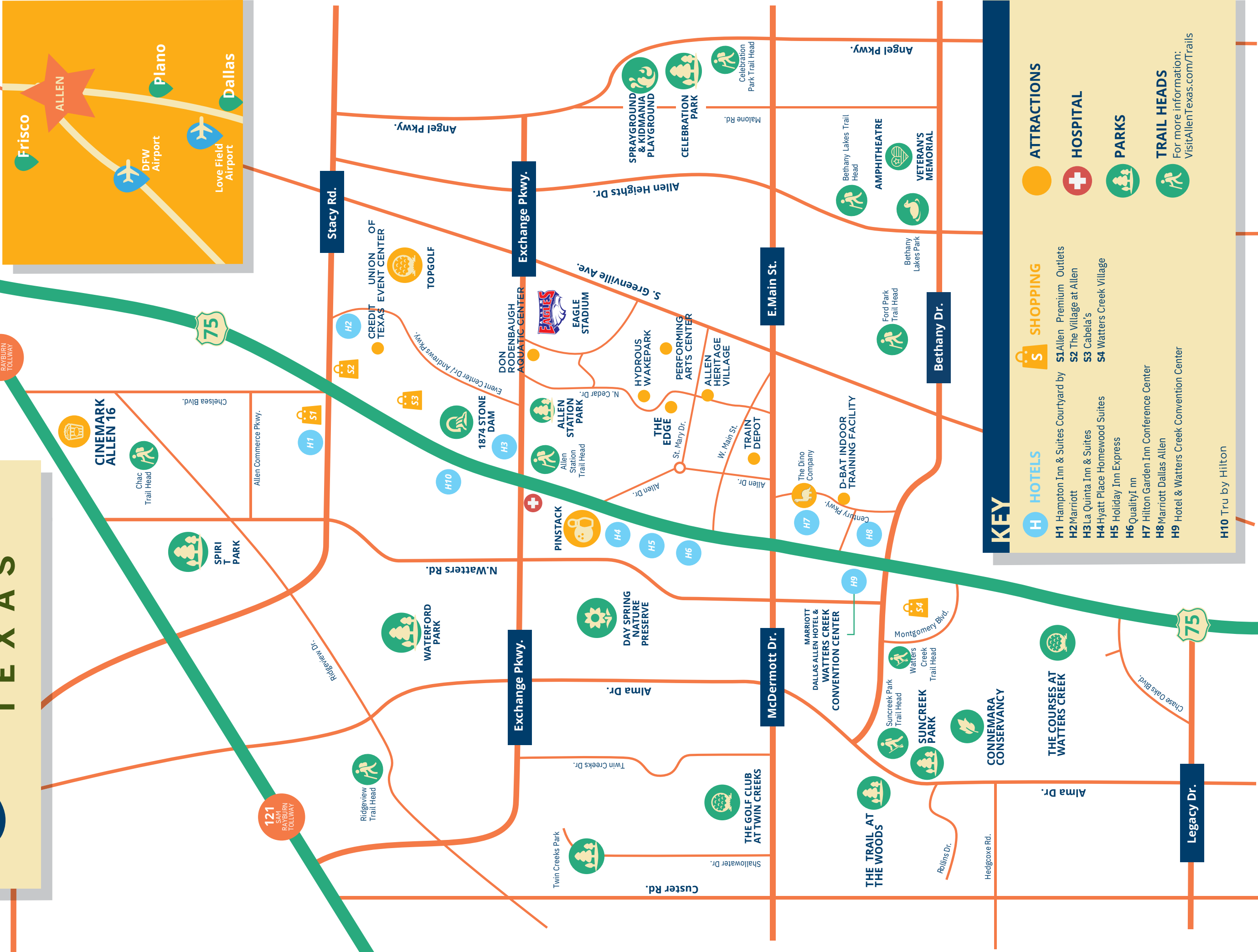

**THE HISTORY OF ALLEN**

Allen's history dates back to before the 1800s, when the region was inhabited by Caddo and Comanche native American tribes who eventually migrated west as European immigrants began arriving in the 1840s.

The original township of Allen was established by the Houston & Texas Central Railroad in 1872 and named for Ebenezer Allen, a state politician and railroad promoter. Railroads have played an integral part in Allen's history. In fact, the first train robbery in Texas took place in Allen on February 22, 1878, when Sam Bass and his associates pillaged the train.

Allen is also home to what is thought to be the last remaining railroad water reservoir dam in the United States, which was once used as a water station for the H&TC Railway. The Texas Historical Commission recognizes the remaining site—which includes the dam, pump house and water tower foundations—as a Texas State Archaeological Landmark.

**ALLEN'S 1874 STONE DAM**

Allen Station Park

Allen is home to the only known stone dam in the United States which was used for transportation purposes. The 1874 Stone Dam was used to create a source of water for the Houston & Texas Central Railway Company's steam locomotives. The Allen Water Station is a Texas State Archaeological Landmark and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Access the dam from Allen Station Park.

**ALLEN HERITAGE VILLAGE**

Allen Heritage Village is a re-creation of three distinct areas that tell Allen's history through the frontier, urban and agricultural periods of the 1920s and 1930s. Also on the property are the original St. Mary Church and the Allen Christian Church—both beautifully renovated and available to rent for weddings and special events.
